# 3rd Annual *"Fall Flurry"* Charity Shoot Event Overview



The "Fall Flurry" Charity Event is a Team Clay Shooting Competition located at Meadow Wood Farm in Waxhaw, North Carolina. Our event is in its third year and has collectively raised over \$14,000.00 to benefit Pat's Place Child Advocacy Center in Charlotte, North Carolina.

Each team will have a total of 5 shooters. Each shooter will have the opportunity to shoot 50 clays at 12 shooting stations around the course at Meadow Wood Farm. At the end of the of the course, each team will shoot 50 clays at the "Flurry" Station. The team with the most clays broken on the 12-station course and Flurry wins! 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Teams will receive prizes for overall score and a prize for most clays shot at Flurry Stand.



Meadow Wood is a private hunting and clay shooting club located on 800 acres just 25 miles south of Charlotte, NC. Their 12-station sporting clay course is great place to shoot clays and practice for those tough shots you will encounter while hunting quail, pheasant, ducks and dove. Each station utilizes two automatic traps to simulate various hunting shots. The stations offer shots at singles, report pairs and doubles. Shots at targets representing teal high in the air, crossing quail and bouncing rabbits are all experienced during a round. Sporting clays offers a safe, competitive way to enjoy shooting with your friends in a controlled shooting situation. It is also a great way to introduce beginners and youngsters to shooting.

## About Pat’s Place



Pat’s Place is the **only** child advocacy center serving Mecklenburg County children affected by sexual abuse. They provide a child-friendly setting where a skilled team of professionals and community professionals work together to evaluate abuse allegations.

Core services for children and their families include:

### Family Advocacy

Master’s Level Social Workers who shepherd the family through the entire investigation process assisting with crisis intervention, court support, linking to community resources, support groups, and most importantly, simply listening to the family. The Family Advocates coordinate an unduplicated, community-wide response and naturally serve as the “touch-point” for the family, keeping them informed and addressing any concerns or fears.

### Forensic Interviewing

Provides the child with an opportunity to tell their story in their own words. It is a child-friendly, neutral setting for collecting facts through a checklist of procedures tailored specifically to the child’s age, development level, and any special barriers. Forensic Interviews are video-recorded for court purposes and are conducted by master-level, clinically licensed social workers.

### Medical Evaluation

Conducted at Pat’s Place through a partnership with Levine Children’s Hospital Pediatric Resource Center by providers specialized in child abuse. The evaluation is a head-to-toe check-up similar to a “well-child” exam, encompassing the child’s entire well-being. Our medical providers help assure parents that their child is healthy and that if abuse has occurred, it will not be visible to others and their child can be successful in coping and healing.

### Multidisciplinary Team Consultation

Child abuse is a community issue that cannot be dealt with by just one agency alone. MDT allows all agencies working on a case to make decisions based on combined information, provide status updates, and pool resources to better ensure a child is being served to the best of our abilities and that no child falls through the cracks.

Incorporated in 2004, Pat’s Place is a non-profit 501(c)3 corporation and is *one of just over 700* centers nationwide accredited by the National Children’s Alliance. Since inception, Pat’s Place *has served over 1,700 children* affected by sexual abuse.

Funds generated through individual contributions and special events like the Fall Flurry account for approximately 70% of the Pat’s Place annual budget. Your participation can provide the following for children served at Pat’s Place:

- \$600 – Provides a full day of court support for six children
- \$1,200 – Provides staffing and supplies for four 12-week survivor support groups
- \$2,500 – Provides forensic interviews for two dozen children
